Labor Day: What it Means

Labor Day, the first Monday in September, is a creation of the labor movement and is dedicated to the social and economic achievements of American workers. It constitutes a yearly national tribute to the contributions workers have made to the strength, prosperity, and well-being of our country.

The First Labor Day

The first Labor Day holiday was celebrated on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City, in accordance with the plans of the Central Labor Union. The Central Labor Union held its second Labor Day holiday just a year later, on September 5, 1883.

In 1884 the first Monday in September was selected as the holiday, as originally proposed, and the Central Labor Union urged similar organizations in other cities to follow the example of New York and celebrate a "workingmen's holiday" on that date. The idea spread with the growth of labor organizations, and in 1885 Labor Day was celebrated in many industrial centers of the country.

Students at JSC are strongly encouraged – and often required – to complete an internship that provides a real and tangible benefit to a community business or organization. Even if there are no current openings at your business, the JSC Career and Internship Fair is your direct link to potential interns and volunteers who can carry out that special project you've been trying to get started.

We also have hundreds of students looking for a part-time college job, a summer job, or the all-important first job after college!

We have done our best to keep costs low and to improve the experience for all. To these ends, we have made the following decisions:

- Registration fees are **\$150 For-Profit** Businesses and **\$100 Non-Profit** Businesses. You can pay online with a credit card or mail us a check. Fee is due upon registration.
- If you attended the Spring 2017 fair, and stayed until the very end, you will have a reduction of \$50 off the fall registration fee (see your special email, just sent).
- When you wait until the end of the fair (3:00) to pack up and leave you will receive another \$50 reduction for the 2018 Spring Career & Internship Fair.
- Your registration fee will cover the cost of lunch for up to 2 people (provided in the Varsity Gym), as well as snacks at the fair. Our new time means that Pizza and Salad will be available in the event space.
- There is a \$10 pp fee for lunch tickets for any additional people above the 2 covered by the registration fee EXCEPT for JSC alums! There is no additional fee for JSC alums, their lunch is free.
- If you cancel up to 14 days before the event: you will receive a full refund
- If you cancel 13-8 days before the event: you will receive a 50% refund
- If you cancel 1 week before the event: there is no refund
- If you do not show up for the event: there is no refund
